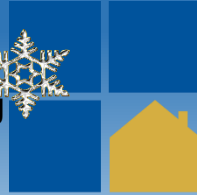

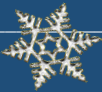


"Breaking the Cycle of Homelessness One Family at a Time"

Did you know... Gage Park is a beautiful 160-acre park and one of the star attractions in Topeka. Gage Park has a history dating back to 1899, when the heirs of Guilford Gage donated 80 acres of land west of Topeka between 6th and 10th Streets.

The zoo was opened in the park in 1933. Additional exhibits were constructed over the years, and in 1963 the city hired its first zoo director, Gary K. Clarke.

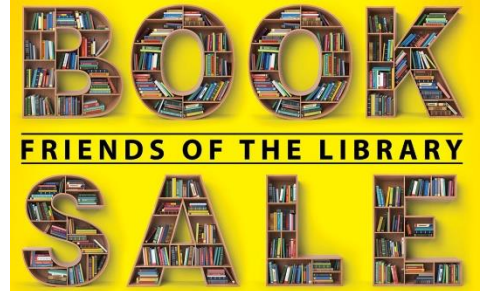

KANSAS DAY, JANUARY 29TH

Kansas Day commemorates the day that Kansas was officially admitted into the Union. On January 29, 1861, Kansas became the 34th state. In 2020, Kansas will celebrate 159 years of statehood.

In Topeka, you can celebrate Kansas Day by attending special activities at the Kansas Museum of History, at the Kansas State Capitol, and by visiting a historic Topeka attraction like Constitution Hall. You can also take advantage of special deals and sign giant birthday cards to commemorate Kansas' Birthday at participating local businesses and attractions the entire month of January.

It is a violation of federal law for a housing provider to refuse to rent or sell a home, to offer unequal terms, quote different prices, or apply different policies on the basis of race, color, religion, disability, or handicap, sex, familial status, or national origin. State law prohibits discrimination on the basis of marital status, ancestry, age, or familial status. Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 bars discrimination in the sale or rental of housing on the basis of a disability or because there are children in the family but, exempts housing for older persons.
