Note: If your check/money order is dated on or before the 6th but, do not turn it in until after the 6th, it is late, and you will receive a late fee.


Jerry's Corner: Spring is hopefully upon us,

Here are a few things you can do around your unit to prepare for the nicer weather:

- Those in single-family homes this is the perfect time of year to change your furnace filter.
- Clean around your exterior A/C units make sure nothing is stuck to the outside of the unit preventing air flow.
- Yard: Make sure to keep as many items as possible off the lawn so there is less of a risk of damage from the mower.

It is a violation of federal law for a housing provider to refuse to rent or sell a home, to offer unequal terms, quote different prices, or apply different policies on the basis of race, color, religion, disability, or handicap, sex, familial status, or national origin. State law prohibits discrimination on the basis of marital status, ancestry, age, or familial status. Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 bars discrimination in the sale or rental of housing on the basis of a disability or because there are children in the family but, exempts housing for older persons.
