Maintaining AC & Property

AC Maintenance: Reminder that this is a good time to change your furnace filter. This should be done at least four times a year. A dirty filter can affect the way your AC runs. If you notice your AC blowing less air or notice your ice on your outside AC unit and inside furnace unit, please check your filter. If the filter is dirty, please replace it to efficiently run the unit. If you are unsure who is responsible for changing your filter, please contact our office @785-232-1650. **Unit Property Maintenance:** All trash needs to be disposed of in the dumpster. Do not accumulate trash, furniture, inoperable vehicles or any other rubbish in the yard or porch. These items attract rats, mice and other pests that could enter the unit.

RENT PAYMENT REMINDER

Rent is due on the 1st of the month; however, we allow until close of the 6th to avoid a late fee. Payments that are mailed with a postmark (not the date on the check or money order) on or before the 6th will not be charged a late fee. Please us the drop box (rear of building) if you are dropping rent off after hours or unable enter the building.

Note: If your check/money order is dated on or before the 6^{th} but, do not turn it in until after the 6^{th} , it is late, and you will receive a late fee.

It is a violation of federal law for a housing provider to refuse to rent or sell a home, to offer unequal terms, quote different prices, or apply different policies on the basis of race, color, religion, disability, or handicap, sex, familial status, or national origin. State law prohibits discrimination on the basis of marital status, ancestry, age, or familial status. Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 bars discrimination in the sale or rental of housing on the basis of a disability or because there are children in the family but, exempts housing for older persons.
